Dr. Ambeth Ocampo will make us take a closer look at the designs of our banknotes and coins and see how these represent our past, culture, and identity as a nation.

He is Chairman of the History Department at the Ateneo de Manila University and an internationally syndicated columnist. He has served as Chairman of the National Historical Institute since 2002-2010 and as Chairman of the National Commission of Culture and the Arts from 2005-2007. He is recipient of three National Book Awards for the Essay, Literary History, and Bibliography categories and is a critically and popularly acclaimed lecturer on Philippine history, culture, and the arts.
